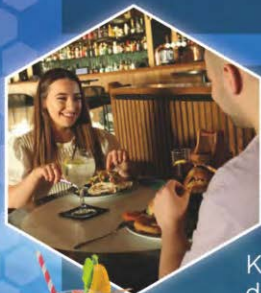

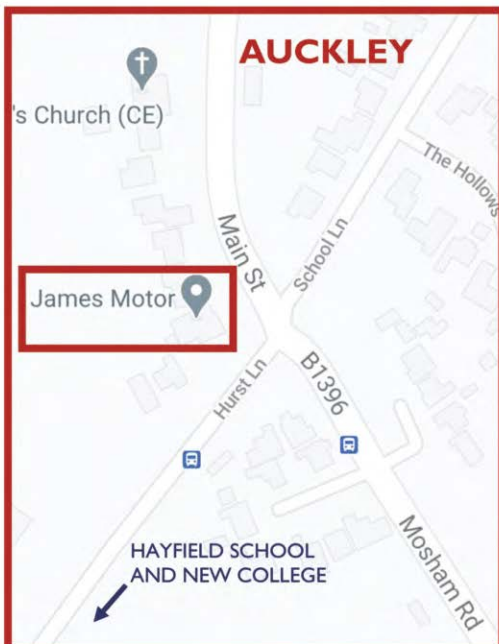

The Origin of the Eagle & Child

Back in the 14th century an ancestor of the Stanleys, Sir Thomas Latham, lived in an area of Lancashire also owned by them close to Lytham-St-Annes. He had one daughter Isabel, but no son to carry on the name. It is said that a serving wench had borne him an illegitimate son, and to enable him to present the baby boy to his wife for adoption, he arranged for

the child to be left at the base of a tree in which there was a bird's nest. The

baby boy was duly adopted, and named 'Oskatel' by Sir Thomas, but in spite of the success of his plan, when Sir Thomas died,

he left all his estate and wealth to his daughter Isabel. The daughter eventually married Sir John Stanley and in memory of her half-brother persuaded him to include in the family coat of arms, "The bird and bastard". This name persisted until propriety required it to be refined as "The Eagle and Child", although many locals still refer affectionately to the pub as "The Bird _".

The first record of these licensed premises shows that an inn has existed on this site since 1492, the present property dating back to 1820. The 23rd April was the recorded date of birth of the illegitimate child, and is therefore the true birthday of the Eagle and Child.

Ghosts of the Eagle & Child.

The Eagle & Child is said to have 3 ghosts. The most 'regular' ghost has been seen many times sitting at a table and his cigarette smoke has been seen lingering after he has left. Rumour has it that when the pub had gone through one of its many improvements, the landlord had banned him from the pub when wearing dirty work clothes. He apparently died the next day and is said to have taken a fancy to one of the cleaning girls who he came back from the dead to see.

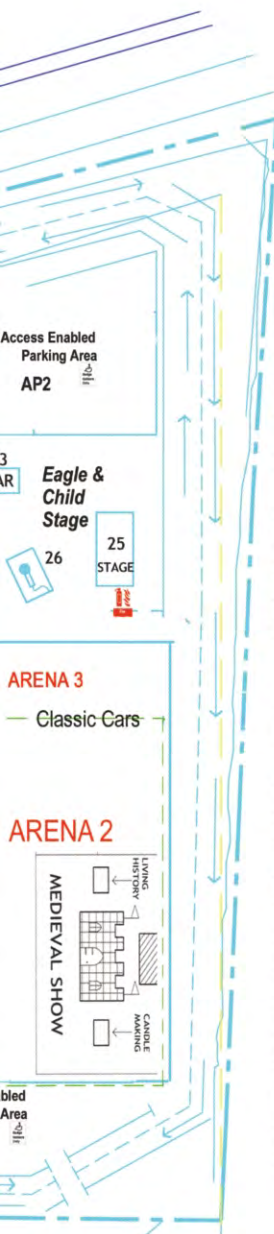

A Family Farm in Auckley since the 1880s

A personal account by local farmer Russell Toothill.

Toothills first farmed Ivy House Farm in the 1880s, with an interval in-between when my grandfather rented it in 1903, from the then owners the Earl Fitzwilliam family. As well as farming we were the local butchers until the Second World War. After which my father John and uncle Roland took over the tenancy.



Sand and gravel companies took ownership of most of the village digging up large areas around Auckley, Blaxton and Finningley. As a child the village was small enough that I would know every family by name but in the 1960s a new sewage scheme prompted massive house building. Only after this in the 1970s were we able to buy part of Ivy House Farm and Brooke Farm, after I returned from agricultural

college. From 200 acres in the 1970s my family and I have built it up to 1400 acres today some owned and some rented.

In the early years one third of the farm would have been grass to feed the horses, which pulled the equipment before tractors. The last 2 carthorses were sold in 1956 replaced by ever-larger tractors. Starting at 17-horse power to today's at 270-horse power. The early tractors were open exposing the driver to snow, rain, sun and wind that often came with choking blinding dust. Today my quiet



cab has air conditioning, dust filters, sat- nav driving aids, music system and press button controls with a price that started at a £100 in the 1940s to often in excess of £500,000 for the biggest models over 500 horse power.



Harvesting Wheat, Barley, Oats and Rye used to involve cutting the crop and tying it in bundles called Sheaves, to be dried in the field to be carted home to stack for threshing out over winter. This could often involve manual handling of the crop up to 8 times, to arrive at a heap of straw and hessian sacks full of grain. Then in the 1950s came the combine

harvester that arrived at straw and grain in one operation from just one man driving from a very dusty driving seat, the early combines took 4ft 6 inches width and harvested 4-5 acres a day. This year's 2022 model cuts 35ft widths and is capable of over 250 acres per day in big fields is computer and climate controlled drivers cab, with tracks and

4-wheel drive. It will also harvest beans, peas, maize, oil seed rape, linseed, soya beans, lupins, sunflowers or grass seed depending on what we decide to grow.

Please park cars with large farm machinery in mind; we need to access fields often into the dark to harvest crops, not governed by what day it is but by the weather.

In my early years we grew 15 acres of Sugar beet, which were weeded by hand hoeing. Harvesting involved up-to 6 times man handling to arrive at the factory for processing 200 tonnes of Sugar beet. No playgroups for me but out in the field as my late mother helped with the hoeing and beet harvest. Today 175 acres of beet are lifted within 4 days producing 5,500 tonnes of Sugar beet using a massive 6 row harvester, emptied using 14 tonne trailers and then up-to 50 28 tonne lorries per day taking it to be processed. Our entire crop runs the factory for half a day.

We still grow grass, as does half the farmed area of Britain. People do not eat grass Cattle and Sheep do. Only by eating meat can we utilise grass to produce food from large areas not suitable for other crops. All the children going to Auckley junior school visit us at lambing time to see up to 700 lambs born. Once grazed around the village and herded along local roads to grass pastures. Today they are moved on transport vehicles to avoid traffic pet dogs and open planned gardens, sadly to graze on distant fields to avoid dog attacks that kill and mutilate thousands of sheep in Britain every year. Please walk you dogs with an available dog lead to be used near sheep; dogs attacking sheep will be legally shot!



Fertilizer, chemical weed control, trace elements (vitamin and mineral supplements for plants) fungal, insect and virus control in plants has provided all of us with cheap disease-free food. The organic agriculture my Grandfather had to use often led to total crop failure and hours of backbreaking physical labour. My own father wore out 2 sets of hip joints. A return to Organic food will again lead to mass hunger until the robots we begin to see planting and weeding become commonplace. If we stop feeding plants fertilizer to grow they will stop feeding us. Yields will decline quickly to a remaining 20% of today's levels. 6 out of 10 meals you eat are still grown on local farms.

Russell Toothill will be at the show displaying vintage and modern farm equipment. You will be able to find him at his big red tractor, where he looks forward to discussing farming in general and any aspect of his article.
