

The School in Auckley

On the 13th July 1838, the St Saviour's Church opened for business. Built with a house for the curate to the rear by the Rev Gervas Harvey Woodhouse (Rector of Finningley), it wasn't just a place of worship, but also served as a school during the week.

The running costs of the school were met partly by contributions from two or three local landowners and partly from a charge of four pence a week for each pupil attending. The teacher was Mrs Elizabeth Hobson who, on an annual salary of twenty pounds, ran the school for children between five and eight years of age for over twenty years

Eventually the Government became interested in developing the educational provision in the country, which until that time had been almost entirely the preserve of the voluntary bodies. The 1870 Education Act required each township to provide schooling for its youngsters. Each existing school in the country was inspected (Auckley's turn was in March 1871) and the arrangements in the village were viewed as being below what was required in terms of both the building and the education provided.


In due course an Auckley School Board was elected, as required by law, and the four farmers who made up the Board under the chairmanship of the curate set about establishing a

brand new, purpose-built school for the village, aimed at catering for up to sixty-five pupils. The school and a house for the master was erected at a cost of £1,608-2-6d and all the villagers were invited to the grand opening, with a celebratory tea and several speeches. The following day there was a party in the new school for all the children in the village and a magic lantern show.



The school opened for business on Monday 9th October 1876, the master being Mr Charles Bedwell. The next quarter of a century were difficult years. There was a constant battle to encourage parents to send their children to school: it was neither compulsory nor free (a few pence a week was the charge for each child). Many parents didn't see the need for education in any case as they had never received any themselves, and would rather have the boys of the family working in the fields and the girls helping out at home.

The curriculum offered in school was basic, with all except the very youngest taught as a single group in one room by the master; the discipline was sometimes delivered at the end of a cane. There was emphasis on learning facts by heart as the report of annual school inspection, which included the testing of the children, impacted on the funding the school received from the government.

In 1880 attendance at school was made compulsory for children aged five to ten and in 1891 it was made free for all. In addition, the compulsory school age was raised to eleven in 1893 and twelve in 1899-the year Mr Bedwell retired and subsequently became the first chairman of the newly-established Auckley Parish Council.

The School Board era came to an end in 1904, the schools in the area becoming the responsibility of the West Riding County Council. Between 1906 and 1928, the headmistress, aided now by another teacher, was Mrs Elizabeth Forster and the school



was very well regarded, the inspectors commenting "This is a very satisfactory country school".

As pupil numbers at the school increased, particularly arising from the housing development taking place in the village in the late seventies, a new school was required. The new six classroom school was built

and children occupied the new building from Monday 26th November 1973. By the time of the formal opening ceremony the school was no longer managed by the West Riding but by the new authority-Doncaster Metropolitan Borough Council. The numbers of pupils continued to increase until each classroom was in use as well as two mobile classrooms, and the former "old school" became the nursery.

In the summer of 1995 the Auckley school celebrated its coming of age with many special events: it was twenty -one years since the move into the new building. One of the events was the planting of a tree near what is now the outside activity area for the younger children and it has grown as a tall reminder of this part of the school's history. A little further along is an oak tree, a tree grown from a clone of the famous Major Oak tree, a clone presented to school in 1998 by the then Mayor of Doncaster, Councillor Mrs Yvonne Woodcock.

Although the number of pupils attending school has remained more-or-less constant for the last twenty-five years or so, it has still been possible, as the school became an academy, for there to be several building extensions and alterations.

There has now been an established school in Auckley for many years, catering for several generations of children. The story of the school is not yet complete; in the years ahead school will continue to adjust to changing circumstances as it strives to serve the local community. We all wish it success.





THE AUCKLEY FAMILY FARM

Changing with Climate, Ukraine War and Unavoidable Retirement.

Climate Change

2022 proved to be the driest year I have ever experienced since I began farming in the 1960s. This cut our maize yield by half and our sugar beet by 30%. The sheep were on winter rations of hay from early summer. Irrigation from the river Torne was stopped by the Environment Agency for 1 day, in which flow then returned to normal levels in spite of

no rainfall. This proves that the flow in the Torne depends on discharges from sewage works allowing farmers to recycle it via irrigation to produce food. The amount of food we produce in the UK in proportion to the amount we eat is declining towards 50%; 30 years ago it was 80%. The Government's reaction to climate change is to take even more land out of food production and into environmental schemes, importing more food from distant countries, destroying millions of hectares of virgin rainforest to do this. As Farmers respond to financial incentives



to plant flower rich meadows, trees, use less fertilizer, weed control and insecticides, the result is even less food produced in the UK.

The application of science holds the key to feed us all and reduce our carbon footprint. For the first time we have applied a bacterial inoculation to growing maize, that will fix atmospheric nitrogen, replacing some of the nitrogen from ammonium nitrate fertilizer, which is made from oil.

We also had 160 hectares of crops grown using material from a digester, which produces gas and electric from crops and food waste. The nutrient rich waste from this is an excellent fertilizer, producing the next year's crops. We are moving towards carbon neutral where the farm holds as much carbon annually as it releases thus reducing global warming.

Ukraine War

The Ukraine War caused fertilizer prices to rise from £250 per tonne to £1,000 per tonne, but these have since returned to more normal levels. Shortages of gas, oil and Russian imports occur on the whim of Putin's War and Western Sanctions. 30% of the wheat, maize and sunflowers traded in the world come from the Ukraine. Without it grain prices will double, resulting in possible Third World famine. Grain prices vary from £300 per tonne in 2022 to only £140 now. We all hope the war soon ends so we can produce food at a price the public can afford in a manner that reflects the changing climate.



Retirement

As a 71-year-old still working, the third generation of Toothill's farming in Auckley is handing over to the fourth.
